Consider the impact of discrimination in all its forms. To consider the issue of bullying and how people are affected emotionally and socially. Explore self-image and what influences our development</p> <p>Problem solving- workout where cases of equal opportunities are being provided or denied. To recognise the signs of bullying and how to support others. Provide advice for different scenarios and be able to signpost further more specialist support.</p> <p>Leadership- Take lead in paired work and activities. Problem solving-

To understand the different types of families and parenting, and how to respond to conflict and changes in relationships

Task relating to how to reduce homelessness amongst young people

Leadership-

Lead on extension debate tasks around homelessness and resolution strategies

Lead on discussion around lifestyle choices, drugs and alcohol.

Lead activity on research of different drugs and pressures relating to drug use.

Creativity-

Produce a TikTok, drama, poem, presentation around the dangers of drug abuse and how to get help.

Numeracy/writing-

Analyse data (statistics and percentages) around homelessness

Written responses to relationship dilemmas.
